Our "S+E+A" programs and activities are designed to explore new ways of engaging youth in significant educational, social and cultural experiences that are otherwise unavailable. The youth build relationships and develop problem solving skills through teamwork and collaboration.

Objective: To create an experiential [S]T[E][A]M focused environment for conscious conversations, interactions, and reactions by exploring concepts of integrative health promotion and mental health wellness; through science, equine and agricultural experiential application.

Youth Development/Enrichment:

At-risk youth and families need safe and engaging development/enrichment options to meet the needs of working families. Participants will benefit from enrichment experiences that help them build background knowledge, increase literacy skills, gain knowledge about farm animals, explore interests, engage in environmental agricultural preservation and develop new exploratory skills. From dance to sports, to entrepreneurship, to equine and agriculture. These experiential programs are designed especially for those whose families have limited economic

resources and are likely not accessible elsewhere. Increasing access and affordability to such learning experiences can help close the disparities and opportunities available to youth growing up in families with low incomes and their peers with greater economic vitality. Hence, we do not assist with homework/projects. This is an experiential

(hands on) program.

Why Does it Work?

- Our after school programs and activities are designed to explore new ways of engaging youth who are at risk
- Our youth build relationships and ownership by developing problem solving and conflict resolution skills through spirited teamwork and cooperation.

• Activities in and around the stables allow participants to interact with diverse people and be exposed to a variety of new experiences.

• Our stables become "home away from home" for participants.

• Spending time on the farm and stables helps youth develop family-like relationships that become an integral component of their lifestyles.
